Health Education England's Genomics Education Programme (GEP) has commissioned the development of new Master's-level qualifications to prepare NHS staff for the use of genomic technologies across healthcare.

The programme is available as a Master's (one year full-time or two years part-time) as well as standalone CPPD modules, with course fees fully funded. Modules are delivered by a network of leading universities across the country, through blended, flexible learning.

Modules include:

- Introduction to human genetics and genomics
- Genomics of common and rare, inherited disease
- Application of genomics in infectious disease
- Pharmacogenetics and stratified healthcare
- Counselling skills for genomics

The GEP is funding 550 Master's places and 900 individual modules for CPPD, to help NHS professionals like you get ready for this exciting new development in healthcare.
